


National Forklift Safety Day!

Forklift Inspection Checklist – Safety Starts Here

Buckle Up – Every Shift, Every Time

Your forklift has a seatbelt for a reason. In the event of a tip-over, wearing your seatbelt could be the one thing that keeps you safe. Don't skip it—clip it.



Slow is Safe

Speeding in a forklift isn't worth the risk. Always drive at a controlled pace and reduce speed near intersections, corners, or pedestrian zones. Sudden stops and turns can cost more than just time.



Control the Load, Control the Risk

Lift and lower loads smoothly. Tilt back slightly for stability while traveling and keep forks low to the ground to improve visibility and safety. Proper handling = fewer accidents and a safer workplace for everyone.
